

# The Best General Contractors in San Jose, California (with Photos)

Houses in the California Bay Area are often pictured as sprawling Mediterranean ranches with white stucco walls and red-tiled roofs. This dates back to Spanish and Mexican influences on the area, ushering in the popularity of adobe material. As time progressed, Victorian tastes migrated to the area as well. This trend continued with the later popularity of Larkin-styled homes, which primarily featured redwood timber framing, adobe walls, and an attached veranda. Mission revivals and historic Queen Anne revivals also left their mark on the San Jose architectural scene in later years, but one of the area's most iconic styles came in the form of renowned architect Frank Lloyd Wright. Hailed as one of the most influential architects of the 19th century, Wright popularized hexagonal-designed houses patterned after the honeycomb of a bee. Further, he pioneered the Prairie style, which became the first indigenous American architecture style.

San Jose's median home value stands around \$1M, on the higher end of the nation's scale, thanks to Silicon Valley's tech wealth. However, the aforementioned are only a few of some of the most popular home styles throughout San Jose and this list is a showcase of those distinct themes courtesy of some of the area's best general contractors.

All of the contractors on this list have been evaluated for accolades, association membership, customer service, and skill in construction. They are all capable of working in a diverse set of styles, and are able to evaluate pre-existing homes and work with clients to create homes that exceed owners' expectations.

with multiple META Awards by NARI.



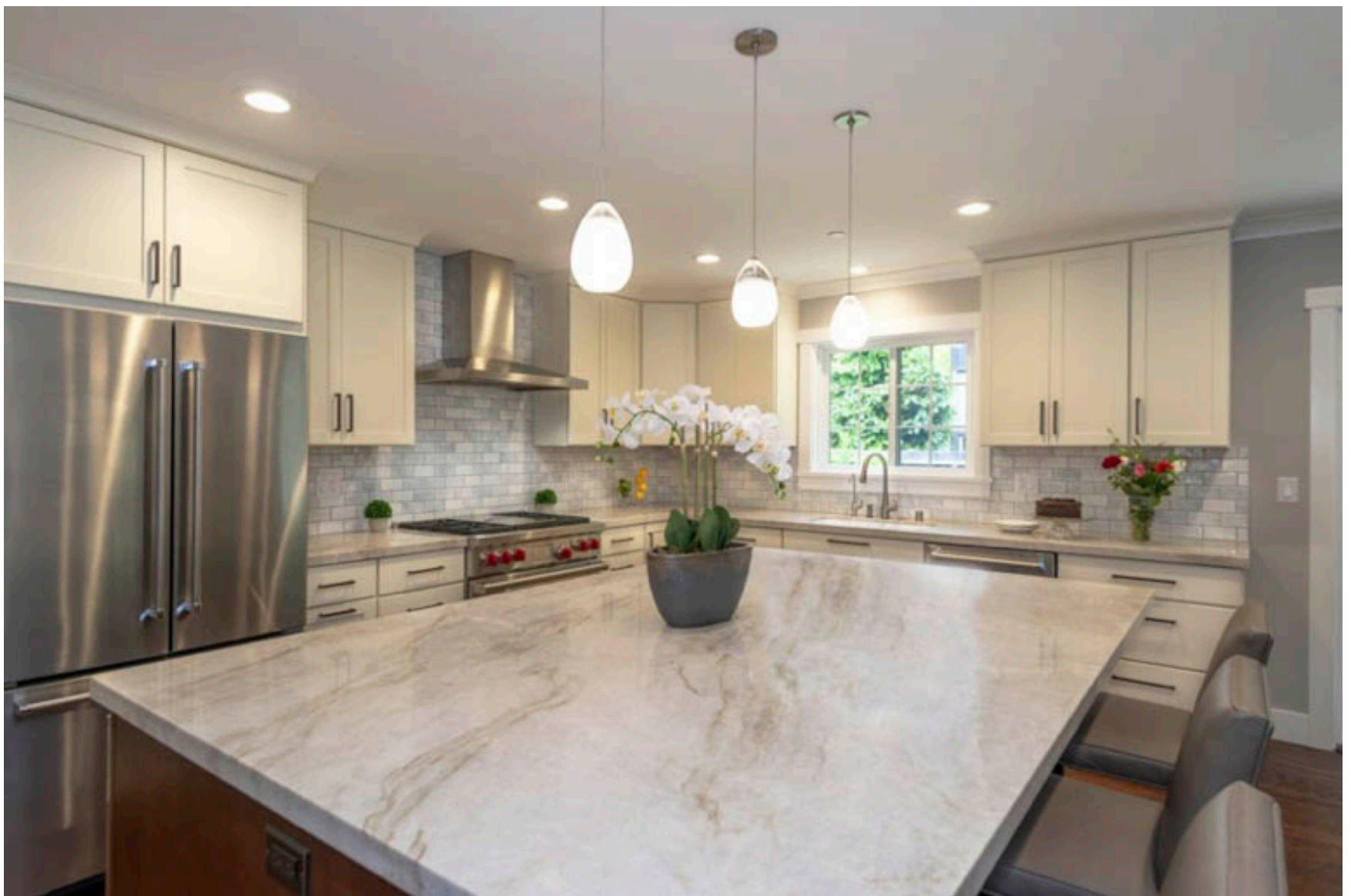
